

## 2024 Variety Grand Draw Terms & Conditions

<b>1</b>	The Grand Draw is being promoted by Variety - the Children's Charity of Jersey. Jersey Charity Commission Registration Number 181

<b>3</b>	No cash alternative to the tangible prizes will be offered
<b>4</b>	The tickets will be numbered from 1,001 to 9,000
<b>5</b>	The Price of a ticket is £20. The purchaser's name and contact details must be written on the counterfoil. The maximum number of tickets which can be sold to any one individual is 20
<b>6</b>	Tickets are not transferable
<b>7</b>	No tickets can be sold outside of Jersey
<b>8</b>	Tickets can be bought online from our website <a href="http://www.varietyjersey.org.je">www.varietyjersey.org.je</a> and the purchaser will receive an email confirmation. ID and proof of age will be verified by YOTI. The Variety Office will then issue and post the tickets only to Jersey residents. Tickets can also be sold to the general public by street sales or from the Variety Office
<b>9</b>	All sold and unsold tickets have to be returned to the Variety Office by Monday 18 <sup>th</sup> November 2024. A detailed register of all tickets sold and unsold will be kept securely at the Variety Office. No unsold ticket numbers will be entered into the draw
<b>10</b>	The Grand Draw will take place on Thursday 28 <sup>th</sup> November 2024, at 7pm during an evening reception at The Boat House, St Aubin
<b>11</b>	Tickets can only be purchased by adults aged 18 years or over. If a ticket is sold to an underage person, Variety will refund the ticket price and take back the ticket. Variety will report any such incident to the Jersey Gambling Commission
<b>12</b>	Children will not be used as agents for the sale of tickets
<b>13</b>	All ticket sales data/records will be kept securely at the Variety Office for 12 months after the date of the draw
<b>14</b>	Tickets and counterfoils will be kept secure at all times
<b>15</b>	The draw will be conducted using a secure Drum which contains the ticket counterfoils
<b>16</b>	The tickets will be drawn in consecutive order from 1 <sup>st</sup> Prize through to the 20 <sup>th</sup> Prize
<b>17</b>	All winners not in attendance will be contacted the same day. Photographic ID will be required for collection. Prizes will be kept for 6 months after the date of the draw
<b>18</b>	The winning ticket numbers will be published on Variety's Website, Facebook, and Twitter pages and also in the local Media
<b>19</b>	The Variety Grand Draw is regulated by the Jersey Gambling Commission under Permit Number CP-2332-24 and is required to provide (JGC) with details of all prize winners
